Cantigny Park Transportation Scholarships

Eligibility Requirements

A teacher or school administrator may apply on behalf of a 4th through 12th grade class or classes.

Schools must be located in the Chicagoland area.

Schools must serve a student population comprised of at least 40% who qualify for free or reduced lunch under the National School Lunch Program.

Scholarships

A maximum scholarship of \$200 may be awarded to cover the cost of transportation to and from the museum. Schools may be awarded up to two scholarships per calendar year.

Scholarship Procedures

To apply for the scholarship a teacher or school administrator must submit the application to the Cantigny Park. Applications must be submitted at least six weeks in advance of the field trip. Scholarships will be awarded to qualifying schools on a first come first served basis. Applications should be sent to:
