



Scout and Girl Scout guests,

We are excited to welcome you back! We are committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for your visit. Here is what you can expect from us:

- When space and capacity allow, groups may have an opportunity to tour the museum with or without the program facilitator.
- Shared surfaces (tables, etc.) will be cleaned by staff before and after use by each scout. Ideally, scouts will be spaced six feet apart, but never less than three feet.
- All staff members will wear a face covering during the program.
- Museum bathrooms will be available to program attendees; however, water fountains have been turned off.
- A hand sanitizing station will be available in the pavilion and the museum.

What we expect of visitors before coming to the program and while at the museum:

- If you are sick, please stay home.
- Visitors must wear a face mask at all times unless they have an exemption for medical necessity. All medical exemptions will require an individualized plan for social distancing and safety measures for other persons.
- Everyone is expected to wash hands or use sanitizer frequently. Hands must be washed or sanitized upon arrival and before and after sharing objects.
- We allow 2-3 chaperones to stay with the program to help keep Scouts on task. No siblings please. These individuals *must remain socially distant and wear masks at all times.*
- Extra drivers and family members are welcome to explore the grounds or leave and return at pick-up time. There is no fee to enter the park if you are driving for a Scout program. Please let the person at the parking booth know which program you are arriving for.
- Please turn in a hold-harmless form for each person attending.
